# BENTON ADVERTISING & PROMOTION COMMISSION Minutes February 9, 2022

### I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Bill Eldridge called the regularly scheduled meeting of the Benton Advertising & Promotion Commission to order on February 9, 2022 at 3:30 pm at the Benton Municipal Complex in Council Chambers.

#### II. ROLL CALL

Commissioners in attendance included: Bill Eldridge, Steve Brown, Luke Moody and Steve Lee. Brandi Crabtree, Elgin Hamner IV and Alison Burch were absent.

#### III. MINUTES

Luke Moody made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 12, 2022 meeting. Steve Brown seconded. Motion carried.

### IV. FINANCIAL REPORTS

Financial reports were presented by Jordan Woolbright. The A&P Commission bank accounts show the following balances as of January 31, 2022:

Bank OZK – Event Center	\$294,442.73
Bank OZK – Savings	\$347,609.47
Total Checking/Savings	\$698,014.02

A&P profit and loss statement: for the month and year to date for January 2022 total income of \$15,292.94 and total expenses of \$82,944.43 resulting in a net loss of (\$67,651.49). Jordan included that the second payment for the downtown lighting project was paid from this account in January in the amount of \$75,000 and is on the financial statement as a capital expenditure.

Event Center profit and loss statement: for the month and year to date for January 2022 total income of \$46,205.11 and total expenses of \$152,494.09 resulting in a net loss of (\$106,288.98). Jordan reported that the 50% down payment was made for the new digital sign in January and is on the financial statement as a capital expenditure.

Focus Group profit and loss statement: for the month and year to date for January 2022 total income of \$15,290.59 and total expenses of \$0 resulting in net income of \$15,290.59.

City of Benton Financial Officer Mandy Spicer presented the bank account report with the following balances as of January 31, 2022:

Collections received in the month of January 2022 were \$154,095.92 which is 13% higher than collections in January 2021. Below are the amounts collected in January of this year along with January of the previous three years:

There are currently only a few delinquencies and they are expected to bring their accounts current by the 10<sup>th</sup> of this month.

Luke Moody made a motion to accept the financial reports as presented. Steve Lee seconded. Motion carried.

### V. FUNDING REQUEST

Gann Museum of Saline County submitted a funding application for \$4,185. Bill Eldridge is the treasurer for the museum and will recuse himself from voting on the request. The Gann Museum is free to the public and has received A&P funding for at least the past four years as noted on the application. This is the first reading of the application and the request will be voted on at the next meeting.

### VI. REPORT FROM BENTON EVENT CENTER

Director Nikki Chumley reported that there have been 11 events in the building since the last A&P meeting including a blood drive with the Arkansas Blood Institute, the Benton High School football banquet, a Vietnamese New Year celebration and a children's consignment sale. Several events that were scheduled have rescheduled due to Covid.

#### VII. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Digital Sign Replacement Nikki Chumley reported that the new sign has been ordered and the approximate shipping date is March 24.
- B. Transfer of Unused 2021 Budgeted Funding Request Funds Bill Eldridge reported that since the last meeting, an additional invoice has been received to be paid from

funding that was approved in 2021. The current amount of unused budgeted funds is \$2,154.84. The amount budgeted for funding in 2021 was \$25,000. Luke Moody made a motion to transfer the unused funds to the A&P Large Project account. Steve Lee seconded. Motion carried.

- C. RFQ for Land for Future Project Development Update Mandy Spicer reported that the RFQ for land to be potentially used for a RV park has been published. All submitted packets will be opened on Wednesday, February 16, at city offices.
- D. 2022 Budget Bill Eldridge directed the commissioners to the proposed 2022 A&P and Benton Event Center budgets. The budgets are based on actual numbers from 2021 except for a few categories that have been adjusted based on this year's situations such as sales tax revenue, funding, contract labor, internet, repairs, supplies, sales revenue other, labor expenses and linens. Steve Brown asked about the contract with the Benton Area Chamber of Commerce and the service agreement fee. Bill Eldridge answered that the he had reviewed this with Gary James and the Benton Chamber wishes to stay under the terms of the current contract for now. Bill said the commission could evaluate the fee at a later time.

Luke Moody made a motion to approve the 2022 budgets for the A&P and the Benton Event Center as presented. Steve Brown seconded. Motion carried.

### IIX. NEW BUSINESS

Policy for Funding – Bill Eldridge asked for volunteers to be on a committee to review the Policy of Application for Funding document to provide more clarity. The committee will be Bill Eldridge, Luke Moody and Steve Brown.

### IX. OTHER BUSINESS

Bill Eldridge recognized John Wilson with Lights by Sparky. John informed the commission that the downtown lighting project was completed this morning with a few last adjustments and that the City has control of the lights. He thanked the commission for choosing his company for this project. Bill provided that Mayor Tom Farmer will do a final inspection of the project and once his approval is received, the final payment will be made. Bill requested that John submit the final invoice in preparation for payment. Steve Lee asked about installing the same lights on additional buildings in downtown. Bill Eldridge answered that the commission could review an expansion of the project if it chose to.

Mayor Tom Farmer reported that the vendor is still waiting on chips for the audio speakers that will be installed in downtown.
