BENTON ADVERTISING & PROMOTION COMMISSION Minutes January 10, 2024

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Bill Eldridge called the meeting of the Benton Advertising & Promotion Commission to order on January 10, 2024 at 3:33 pm at the Benton Municipal Complex in Council Chambers.

II. ROLL CALL

Commissioners in attendance included: Bill Eldridge, Steve Brown, Alison Burch, Elgin Hamner IV, Luke Moody, Greg Shinn and Frank Baptist. No one was absent.

III. MINUTES

Steve Brown made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 13, 2023 meeting. Luke Moody seconded. Motion carried.

IV. FINANCIAL REPORTS

Financial reports were presented by Jordan Woolbright. The A&P Commission bank accounts show the following balances as of December 31, 2023:

There is a liability of \$1,107.25 owed to the Arkansas Department of Finance for sales tax and to the City of Benton for sales tax.

A&P profit and loss statement: for the month of December 2023 total income of \$16,574.37 and total expenses of \$9,633.33 resulting in net income of \$6,941.04. For the year to date as of December 2023 total income of \$205,928.52, total operating expenses of \$166,679.94 resulting in net income of \$39,248.58.

Event Center profit and loss statement: for the month of December 2023 total income of \$49,950.63, total operating expenses of \$59,935.44 and capital expenditures of \$18,919.69 resulting in a net loss of \$28,904.50. For the year to date as of December 2023 total income of \$722,734.40, total operating expenses of \$539,681.27 and capital expenditures of \$140,418.47 resulting in net income of \$42,634.66.

Focus Group profit and loss statement: for the month of December 2023 total income of \$17,642.09 and total expenses of \$0 resulting in net income of \$17,642.09. For the

year to date as of December 2023 total income of \$215,502.07 and total expenses of \$0 resulting in net income of \$215,502.07.

Bill Eldridge added that approximately \$910,000 from the large project checking account was used last week to purchase tract 2 of the Thomas land. He reminded the commissioners that it was a cash purchase with no interest.

Luke Moody made a motion to accept the financial reports as presented. Alison Burch seconded. Motion carried.

V. Collections received in the month of December 2023 were \$163,482.66 which is 10% higher than collections in December 2022. Collections for January to December 2023 total \$2,033,287.89. Below are the amounts collected in December of this year along with December of the previous four years:

Mandy Spicer reported that there are nine delinquent A&P payers. Two of them are two months past due and seven of them are one month past due. All of the business owners/managers have been contacted and she expects payments to be received soon.

VI. FUNDING REQUESTS None.

VII. REPORT FROM BENTON EVENT CENTER

Nikki Chumley reported that there have been seven events since the last meeting with 4,028 attendees, including a gun and knife show, several Christmas parties and bingo. She also reported that she is expecting the last proof of the No Parking signage this week and then it will be ordered and installed.

VIII. REPORT ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF EXIT 114 PROPERTY Bill Eldridge reported that there is no update since the last meeting other than the

purchase of tract 2 as previously reported.

IX. OLD BUSINESS

Bill Eldridge reported the finance committee is meeting this Friday to work on the 2024 budget. The committee is comprised of Nikki Chumley, Gary James, Jordan Woolbright, Mandy Spicer, Amy McCormick and Bill Eldridge.

Steve Brown asked about the approved funding amount at of the end of 2023. Amy McCormick reported that \$47,910 was approved in 2023 and invoices totaling \$35,056.05 have been paid. The last funding request approved in December was for an event to be held this month and invoices can be submitted until the end of January to be paid.

X. NEW BUSINESS

Amy McCormick informed the commissioners that she will contact Bank OZK to start the process for new signature cards for the bank accounts. Only current active commissioners (Bill Eldridge, Allison Burch, Steve Brown, Frank Baptist, Luke Moody, Greg Shinn and Elgin Hamner IV) and Gary James need to have signature authority on the accounts. At this time, she believes Frank Baptist and Greg Shinn need to be added and Scott Elliott and Steve Lee need to be removed.

XI. OTHER BUSINESS

None.

XII. ADJOURNMENT

Luke Moody made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Steve Brown seconded. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 3:45 pm.
