# BENTON ADVERTISING & PROMOTION COMMISSION Minutes of Special Called Meeting September 22, 2022

#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Bill Eldridge called the special called meeting of the Benton Advertising & Promotion Commission to order on September 22, 2022 at 3:35 pm at the Benton Municipal Complex in Council Chambers.

#### II. ROLL CALL

Commissioners in attendance included: Bill Eldridge, Steve Brown, Alison Burch, Brandi Crabtree, Elgin Hamner IV, Steve Lee and Luke Moody. No one was absent.

#### III. CIVIL STATEMENT

Bill Eldridge read the city's Civil Statement.

#### IV. MINUTES

Steve Lee made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 10, 2022 meeting. Alison Burch seconded. Motion carried.

#### V. FINANCIAL REPORTS

Financial reports were presented by Jordan Woolbright. The A&P Commission bank accounts show the following reconciled balances as of August 30, 2022:

A&P profit and loss statement: for the month of August 2022 total income of \$17,173.52 and total expenses of \$14,048.47 resulting in net income of \$3,125.05. For the year to date as of August 2022 total income of \$122,054.41, total operating expenses of \$82,299.41 and capital expenditures of \$75,000.00 resulting in a net loss of (\$35,245.00).

Event Center profit and loss statement: for the month of August 2022 total income of \$56,672.91, total operating expenses of \$35,765.09 and capital expenditures of \$55,037.51 resulting in a net loss of (\$34,129.69). The capital expenditure was the purchase and installation of new projectors. For the year to date as of August 2022 total income of \$426,651.14, total operating expenses of \$296,836.14 and capital expenditures of \$276,242.25 resulting in a net loss of (\$146,427.25).

Focus Group profit and loss statement: for the month of August 2022 total income of \$17,176.53 and total expenses of \$0 resulting in net income of \$17,176.53. For the year to date as of August 2022 total income of \$122,060.67 and total expenses of \$0 resulting in net income of \$122,060.67.

VI. Collections received in the month of August 2022 were \$170,989.88 which is 7% higher than collections in August 2021. Below are the amounts collected in August of this year along with August of the previous three years:

There are currently eight delinquencies and all are expected to pay within the next 30 days. Janice is doing a great job reaching out to the organizers of special events and festivals to make sure participating food trucks are aware of the A&P tax.

Steven Brown made a motion to accept the financial reports as presented. Elgin Hamner IV seconded. Motion carried.

### VII. FUNDING REQUEST

### Old Fashioned Day

A funding application from the Senior Adult Center for Old Fashioned Day for \$5,000 has been submitted and this is the second reading. Sherry Parsons was present on behalf of Old Fashioned Day. After reviewing the application, Steve Lee made a motion to approve \$5,000 in funding. Luke Moody seconded. Motion carried.

### VIII. REPORT FROM BENTON EVENT CENTER

Director Nikki Chumley reported that 13 events have been held in the building since the last A&P meeting, including a 2-week children's consignment sale and three other multiple day events. The sports card and memorabilia show had its largest show ever with 500 attendees.

#### IX. OLD BUSINESS

A. Benton Event Center Cleaning Service – After the last A&P meeting, Luke Moody contacted the people he mentioned who might be interested in providing cleaning services. Unfortunately, none of them were a viable option. Nikki explained that finding a reliable part-time independent contractor for cleaning at odd hours of the day has been very difficult. She believes hiring a cleaning service would be more reliable at this point. Nikki reached out to four companies to request bids to clean the bathrooms, lobby area and kitchen on a multiple times per week schedule provided to the vendor at the beginning of the month. The event center will continue to provide cleaning supplies. Following are the bids she received:

Cleaning With Pride \$35.00 per hour / per person
First Impressions \$32.00 per hour / per person
Hog Wild Services \$137.50 per hour / no person limit
KJ's Cleaning Crew Passed due to present work load

Mayor Tom Farmer consulted with City Attorney Baxter Drennon who said hiring a cleaning service needs to go through the City's formal bid process. Nikki will work with Mandy Spicer to complete the bid forms.

B. <u>Retail Strategies</u> – Gary James reported that meetings with representatives from Retail Strategies continue to complete the initial research of the city to determine the next steps in recruiting businesses.

### X. NEW BUSINESS

- A. <u>Commissioner Term Expiration</u> Amy McCormick informed the commissioners that one of the hospitality/restaurant representative terms expires in October 2022. As required, an ad has been running in the Saline Courier advertising the vacancy to be filled with the deadline of October 22, 2022. The information received from applicants will be presented to the commissioners at the October meeting and the approved candidate will be presented to the Benton City Council at its October meeting for a vote. If the candidate is approved, he/she will be sworn in at the November A&P meeting.
- C. <u>Survey for Potential Land Purchase</u> Bill Eldridge explained that there is approximately 600 acres of land on the northeast corner of exit 114 along the river that could be a possible location for a RV park but a survey needs to be performed to determine the viability of the land. Luke Moody made a motion to issue a bid request for a surveyor to perform a survey of the approximately 600 acres of land located on the northeast corner of exit 114. Alison Burch seconded. Motion carried.
- XI. OTHER BUSINESS None.

XII. **ADJOURNMENT** 

> Luke Moody made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alison Burch seconded. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 4:00 pm.
